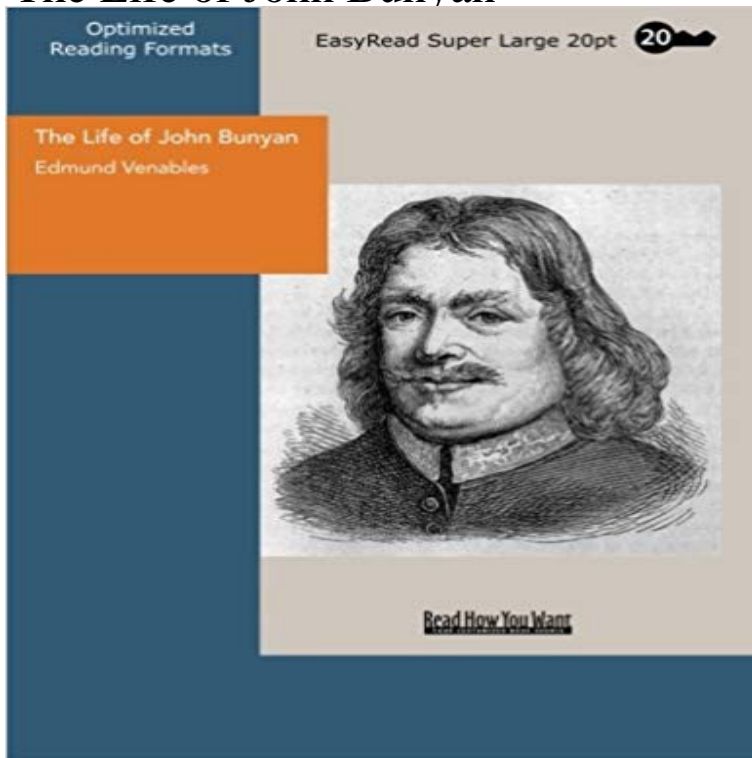


The Life of John Bunyan
