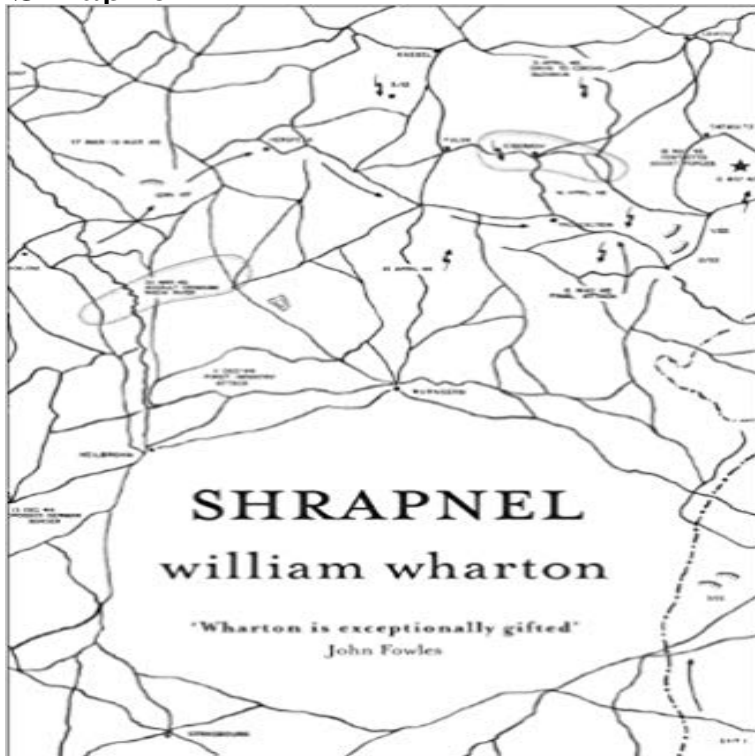


Shrapnel
